The Mayor and Council Members would like to take this time to thank you, our residents, for your support and commitment to our Town. The Town's website is up and running check it out wausauflorida.net. **If you have questions or concerns, please contact us at the Town Hall.** Upcoming events that are planned by the Wausau Community Development Club, Wausau Volunteer Department, and the Town of Wausau are listed below.

- **Great News we are now able to take credit/debit cards for utility payments. You can do this in the office or go to our website at wausauflorida.net and use the pay now button to process your payment. You will need your account number, please call the office if you need to get this information.**
- **Our Town Clerk, Mrs. Margaret Riley will be retiring September 30th and the Town of Wausau will be celebrating her after the monthly Town Council meeting on September 21st if you would like to congratulate her on retirement please stop by.**
- **Our Fall Clean-up is September 23, through October 2, 2023 and we will have dumpsters behind Wausau Town Hall during these dates. Please utilize this time to drop off non-hazardous materials and help us clean up our town. Thank you for your help and if you have any questions about our litter control ordinances, please call Town Hall 850-638-1781.**

- **Grant Updates:**

We have two Disaster Recover Projects: These projects are in the environmental review process.

- **Second Avenue Drainage Project in the amount of \$407,542.00 this improves the drainage at the culvert on Second Avenue**
- **Potable Water (well project) 330,110.00 this project includes a new submersible pump, new piping up to the elevated tank, and a new generator.**

One Mitigation Project: This project is nearing the procurement stage, then the environmental review will begin.

- Paving of Cora Lane & Old Drive in the amount of \$1,044,928.00.

2 FDOT MSCOP Grants: (Municipal Small County Outreach Program) we have received the notice to proceed with these projects.

- Resurface and drainage on Jackson Street \$195,659.00
- Resurface and drainage on Jackson Street \$472,986.00

One CDBG-CV (Crona Virus) for the Collins house in front of the town hall for a community center/ clinic we are partnering with the hospital and the health department for flu shots, covid vaccines, etc. This grant is for \$1,384,090.00

The town has applied for CDBG projects to improve Rogers Square. This property was donated to the town by the Rogers Family and we have applied for a grant to improve the structure to meet ADA standards.

We are also applying to the Florida Legislature for Legislative Incentives monies to complete the Possum Palace, please urge your Senators and Representatives to support this project for the Town.

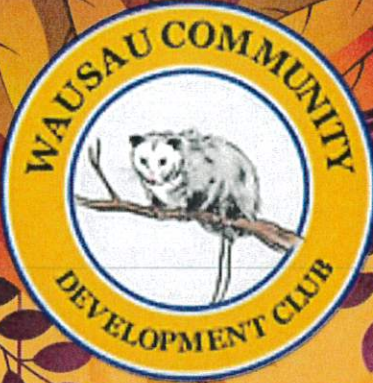

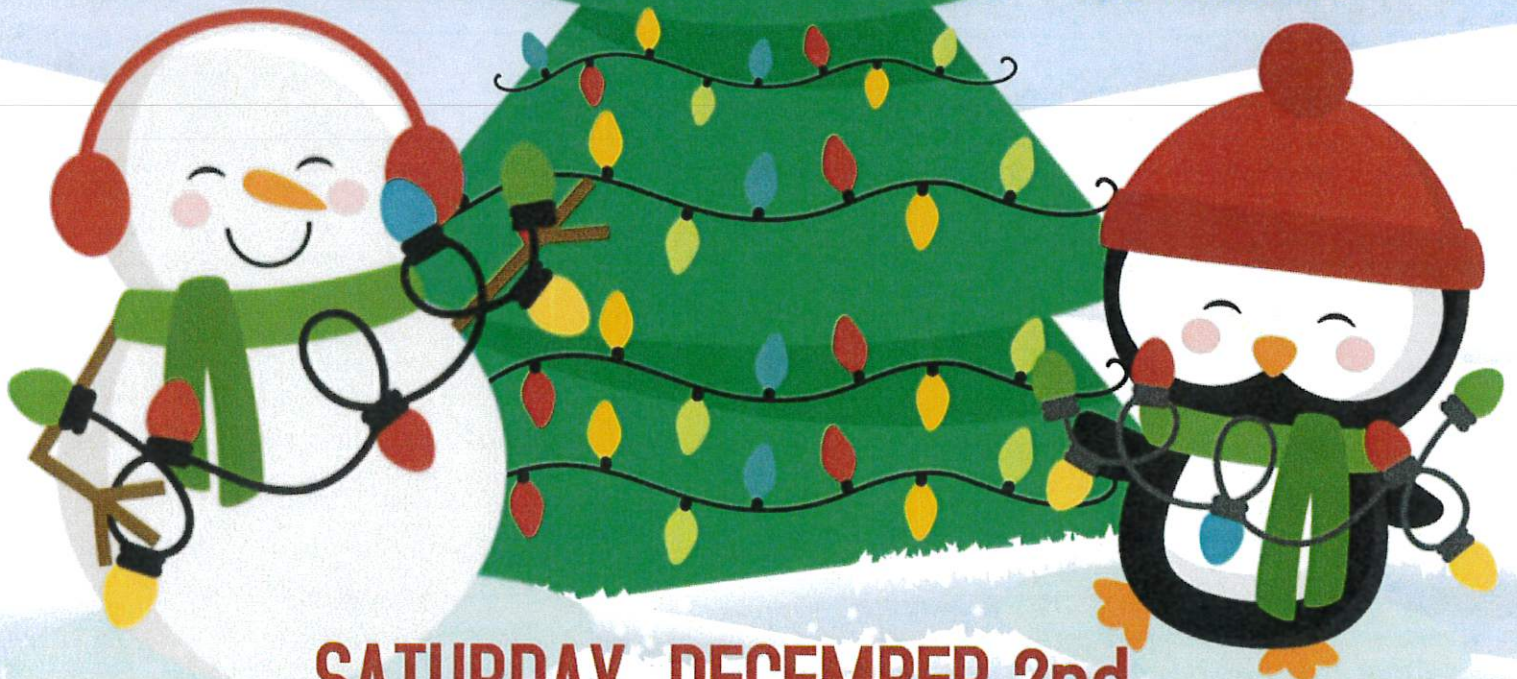

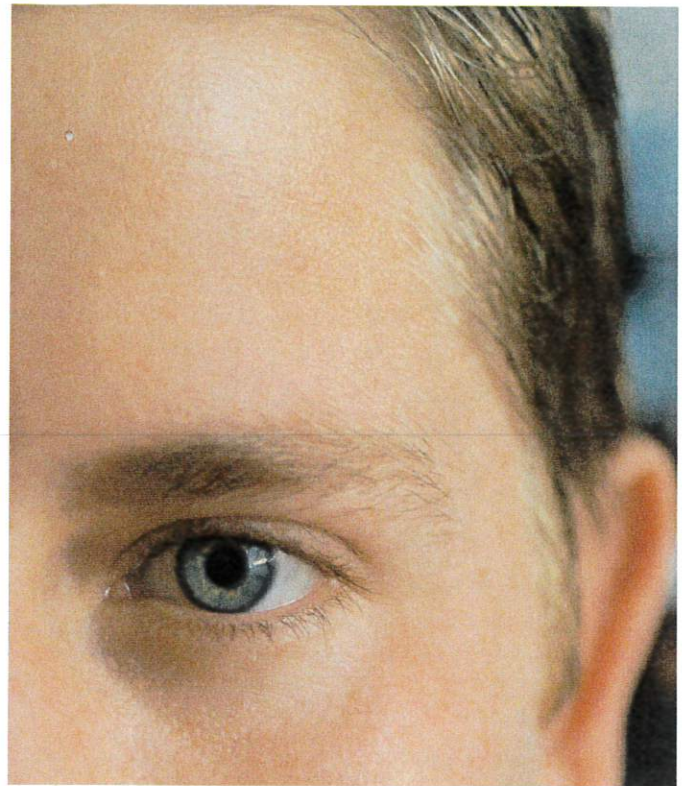
